Warning light details: This indicates a malfunction in the vehicle charging system. Correction process: If necessary, perform maintenance. Warning light detail: It lights up for about 3 seconds, then flashes for about 15 seconds approximately 4,500 miles (7,200 km) after resetting maintenance data. Correction process: If necessary, perform maintenance. Failure to detect the cause of the following warnings may result in abnormal system operation and a possible cause of the accident. Inspect the vehicle immediately by your Toyota dealer. Indicates malfunction in: ABS; or braking assistance system. This warning indicates the possibility of damage to the vehicle that may lead to an accident. Stop the vehicle in a safe place immediately and contact your Toyota dealer. It shows that the engine oil pressure is too low. When the light comes on: low inflationary pressure. Correction procedure: Adjust tyre inflation pressure. The light will turn off after a few minutes. If the light doesn't go out even after adjusting for tyre inflation pressure, check the system by your Toyota dealer. If the cause of this alert is not investigated, the system may function abnormally and may cause an accident. Inspect the vehicle immediately by your Toyota dealer. Indicates a malfunction in: electronic engine control system; Electronic throttle control system; electronic automatic transmission control system. Correction process: Make sure all doors and trunk are closed. Open door warning bell: The open door warning bell warns the driver that one or more doors or trunks are not fully closed (with the vehicle achieving speeds of 3 mph [5 km/h]). Indicates that the remaining fuel is about 2.8 gallons. (10.5 L, 2.3 Imp. gal.) or less Correction procedure: Refuel with a vehicle. Low level of washing liquid correction procedure: Fill the container. If the vehicle gets stuck in fresh snow or mud, TRAC/VSC systems can reduce power from engine to wheel. You're you need to shut down the system so that you can rock the vehicle to free it. To turn off the TRAC system, quickly press and release the button. TRAC OFF indicator should be entered. Press the switch again to turn the system back on. If the indicator is flashing faster than usual, make sure that the bulb from the front or rear signal lights has not burned. Fog lamps are low-set lights directed towards the pavement directly in front of the vehicle. These lights are designed to shine under fog rather than omele, and are therefore less inclined to reflect light rays back into the driver's eyes. High beam headlights help the driver visibility by projecting a bright beam far down the road. They should only be used in situations where they cannot blind oncoming traffic. Typical uses would be in remote areas such as mountains or deserts. Your vehicle is equipped with a passenger classification system. This system detects the conditions of the front passenger seat and activates or deactivates the front passenger devices. THE AIRBAG ON/ AIRBAG OFF the light lights up to make the driver and front passenger aware of the status of the system. If one or more wheels start turning (sliding), the slide indicator flashes to indicate that vehicle stability control (VSC) and/or traction control (TRAC) are working to regain traction. If the light remains in progress, this could indicate a malfunction in the: VSC system; or TRAC cruise control indicator: indicates that cruise control is in progress. Cruise control is a feature designed to maintain the set speed on an open road, without the need for the driver to hold the accelerator pedal. The control stem has a master ON/OFF switch, speed set function and +/- function that provides moderate acceleration or coasting/deceleration. Indicates that cruise control is set to the selected speed. Correction procedure: Fasten the seat belt. The available Blind Spot Monitor (BSM) switch lights up when the system is turned on. When the vehicle is detected in a blind spot, the external rearview mirror on that side of the vehicle glows. If the dictation signal lever is operated when the vehicle is in a blind spot, the external rearview mirror indicator flashes. This warning indicates a possible problem in the braking system. Stop the vehicle in a safe place immediately and contact your Toyota dealer. Low Liquid Failure in the brake system This light also turns on when the parking brake is not released. If the light is fully removed after the parking brake has been fully transmitted, the system normally operates. It indicates a malfunction in the Blind Spot Monitor. The right majority of the temperature display segment of the engine cooling flow flashes to indicate that the engine is almost overheating. The AUTO LSD system helps traction by using a traction control system to control engine performance and braking when one of the rear wheels starts spinning. The system should only be used when one of the spinning rear wheels appears in a ditch or rough surface. Briefly press the VSC OFF switch. At this time, the AUTO LSD indicator will be entered. To turn on the system, press the switch again. Indicates that the Active Traction Control System (A-TRAC) has been activated. The active traction control system automatically helps prevent four wheels from turning when the vehicle is activated or accelerated on slippery road surfaces. 4WD models with several working hours. Stop the vehicle, move the lever to N and move the front-wheel drive lever to L4. Full-time 4WD models: Stop the vehicle, move the lever to N, then push and turn the 4WD control switch to L4L. Press the A-TRAC switch to activate the system. At this point, the A-TRAC indicator will occur. To cancel the system, press the switch again. Indicates that the central differential is locked (full-time 4WD models). Indicates that the Search Control (CRAWL) is active. Crawl Control allows you to travel on extremely rough off-road surfaces at fixed low speed without pressing the accelerator pedal or brake pedal. Reduces the loss of towing or sliding of vehicles while driving on slippery road surfaces, for stable driving. The search control indicator turns on and the slide indicator flashes when you perform the operation. With Downhill Assist Control (DAC), the vehicle can be lowered down a steep hill while maintaining a constant low speed of about 3 mph (5 km/h) without brake pedal operation. To control the system, press the DAC switch. The Downhill Assist Control (DAC) indicator will appear to show that the downhill assistance control system has been activated. Pressing the switch again turns off the system. The 4WD indicator turns on when selecting H4, N, or L4 mode. It shows that high-speed 4WD has been activated. It shows that low-speed 4WD has been activated. Indicates that the Multi-Terrain Selection system is active. The Multi-Terrain Selection system has four field modes. When terrain mode is selected in accordance with terrain conditions, engine power and active traction control system are managed to improve off-road driability. In addition, guidance messages such as tips for choosing how to transfer are displayed on the accessories meter to help the driver drive. Indicates that the side curtain airbags (RSCA) are off. This switch should only be used in a situation where inflation is not desired (examples during extreme off-road driving). Press and hold the ON/OFF key for a few seconds. Vehicles without a smart key system: The RSCA OFF indicator turns on (only when the engine switch is in the ON position). The air bag roll sensor function of the shield curtain and seat belt pretensions will automatically turn on each time the engine switch turns into on position. Cruise control is a feature designed to maintain the set speed on an open road, without the need for the driver to hold the accelerator pedal.
