Verywell / Joshua Seong After postponing the release, the Social Security Administration has unveiled the most popular baby names of 2019. The top name for boys remains unchanged, but the decade ended with a new favorite on the girls' side. The Social Security Administration (SSA) has released its official list of the country's most popular baby names for 2019, and there's a surprising shakeup at the top. After five consecutive years as the most popular name for girls, Emma has been overtaken by Olivia, who was ranked 2nd in each of those years. The 18,451 new Olivias born in the U.S. in 2019 accounted for just over 1% of all female births last year. For the third year in a row, Liam is the most popular name for boys, with 20,502 new births. The SSA announced in May that the 2019 list would be postponed – due to the COVID-19 pandemic – past the typical release date just before Mother's Day. The list for 2020 would be released around that time in 2021, after all data for the year have been collected. The results are based on Social Security card applications for births in the United States. Ethan is the only new name in the top 10, replacing Logan as the 10th most popular name for boys. This is far from unusual- there is often very little change at the top of the year. While Olivia and Liam top the list for 2019, neither are the most popular names of the decade. That honor goes to the names Noah and, not surprisingly, Emma. Emma has ruled supreme for half of the 2010s, and ends up being the most popular general name of the decade. In fact, Emma hasn't finished outside the top 3 since all the way back in 2002. Noah had a similar run at the top from 2013 to 2016, and has been runner-up to Liam in the years since. Every year, for the first time, new names jump into the top 1,000, often in response to celebrities with unique names or beloved pop culture characters. Making two of the biggest jumps on the boys side in 2019 were Sekani and Seven, reaching the top 1,000 for the first time ever, possibly as a tribute to characters from the popular late-2018 film The Hate U Give. Another name on the rise is Archie, who won more than 300 spots last year thanks to the son of Prince Harry and Meghan Markle. On the girls' side, Lyanna topped the top 1,000 in 2017 and joined Arya as another Game of Thrones-inspired entry, which has reached more than 200 spots since 2018. Arya has been in the top 1000 since 2010 and has finished 92 and finished in the top 100 for the first time. Some of the names that fell the most in 2019 are Jaxtyn and Brysen for boys, and Emmarie and Tatiana for girls. Karen Karen slipped 23 spots, but the continued decline over the past decade could reach new lows in 2020 given the explosion this year as a pejorative term. The most popular baby names from year to year are remarkably stable, with larger changes revealing themselves only over many years. The SSA's annual list is a great way to look at the latest trends or test how unique your name ideas are, or to determine how timeless a particular name might be. For example, while Olivia and Emma have been very popular for about two decades, neither are among the top 40 names for girls over the past 100 years. Meanwhile, the most popular name by far in the last century- Mary- has not cracked the top 100 since 2008!
